### Mental Health team in school

Last year, we successfully applied to be a host school for Mental Health Support Team a mental health support team to be based in our school for 7 years, to further develop our mental health and wellbeing offer for children and families in school.

We now have Peter, Beth and Jess as our MHST (Mental Health Support Team) colleagues attached to our school now, and I can confirm that the work to support children in school has already started with some of our families and children, and we hope that this is proving effective from the family point of view. #### **Earrings**

Wearing earrings at school is not allowed for health and safety reasons. If your child currently has earrings in, they will be asked to remove them. As you can imagine, whilst playing outside at playtimes, should another child catch their ear, this could possibly result in a nasty accident.
