Robinwood

Medication for Robinwood

A reminder to our Year 4 parents regarding any medication for the residential: 12 noon on Monday 20th June is the last possible time to send medication into the school office. There are procedures internally that staff are required to do in liaison with the local authority, and we require two days for this to happen. PLEASE NOTE: if any medication is handed in to the school office after this time it will not be accepted. Thank you for your support with this matter.

Term dates

We have received a few queries from parents about when term dates start and end. Although North Tyneside Local Authority release a template of term dates each year, our school does not necessarily have to follow these dates. We are a Foundation School, not a Local Authority school and it is the decision of individual schools as to whether they adopt or amend these dates. Please do not refer to North Tyneside's school term dates online, but instead refer to our school website where our school term dates may be found for this academic year and 2022-23. Please note the day of the week that term ends in Summer and Autumn this year in particular.

Times Table statutory check

On Monday 20th June, Year 4 will sit the statutory Times Table test that Year 4 children nationally must sit. We would be grateful if parents could check Google Classroom for times table homework tasks as preparation for the test on the Monday, thank you.



Parents appointments

Usually we hold an open afternoon in Summer term, for parents to look at children's books and speak to staff. This year we have changed this slightly; we will be having an afternoon and evening of short 5 minute face-to-face parent appointments instead. On Wednesday 13th July, after the annual reports to parents have been sent home, appointments will be held between 1 pm-5 pm.

A text will be sent out to inform parents when the system goes live for booking the appointments on Monday 4th July. We really look forward to the opportunity of meeting parents face to face, after a very long time.

Breakfast Club from September

As you are aware, the cost of gas and electricity has risen significantly, and unfortunately this has also affected our school and has had implications for our budget. As from this month, costs for gas and electricity for school have risen to around £53,000 which is more than double the cost we have paid over recent years.

The Staffing & Finance Committee of Governors and I have worked hard to balance the budget this year, and we have tried our hardest not to put additional costs onto families, whilst also trying to ensure that staffing isn't affected in school - which in turn ultimately affects the children, who are our priority.



Since numbers have risen quite dramatically in the mornings since last September, I have also had to direct an additional member of staff into breakfast club on some days. For both of these reasons, we are in a difficult position but have worked to try and make the increase as small as we can possibly make it. Thank you for your understanding.
