# New pedestrian gate system

As mentioned on a previous newsletter, we are having an electronic buzzer system fitted on the pedestrian gate at the main entrance of school. The workmen have already completed half of the job. Once the new gate system is completely finished and in place, we will text all parents to inform you.

The pedestrian gate will be open from **7.40am** and will remain open until 9am. Anyone arriving to school after 9am will have to press the buzzer and speak to the school office before entering the school site. There will be a similar arrangement at the end of the school day. At home time, the gate will be open from **3.10pm** and will remain open for the collection of children from clubs.

For anyone collecting from pre-school and Nursery for 11.45am, the gate will be open from 11.40am. At any other times except these, you will need to press the buzzer to gain entry to the school site.
