Cash free

As of next week, our school will be a cash free school. We have been moving towards this for the last couple of years and unfortunately this means that we can no longer accept a dual system of cask and online payments. School holidays this academic year

Last year, when we originally sent out to families the dates for the school holidays 2021-22, it did not take into account the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. As you will be aware, there are an additional two bank holidays for the general public which fall within May half term. I can now confirm that this year due to the jubilee, schools only have to work 189 days instead of the usual 190 days, so May half term will now be the following dates. (Please note that there are TWO Teacher Training days immediately after May half term)

Parents appointments Spring term

For this to still be managed safely, I have to point out that:

- only ONE parent may attend to view the child's books
- parents will not be able to stay longer than the allocated class slot
- Every parent coming into the building must still wear a face mask.

NB. You do not have to book an appointment in order to look at your child's books
