Move up day

On Tuesday 11th July, the classes will all move up internally in school, allowing the children to spend half a day in the morning visiting their new classes and class teachers. This includes new Nursery children, who will also join us for move up morning.

Year 1 phonics test

Next week our Year 1 children will sit the statutory phonics test. The children will complete the test on a one-to-one basis out of the classroom with Miss Wright. We regularly assess the children as part of our Read Write Inc assessments ahead of moving the children into new groups, so it is an activity that they are used to doing. In addition to Year 1 doing the phonics test, any Year 2 children who did not achieve the pass mark in Year 1 are required to re-sit the test. These children will sit the test with Miss Knowles. All phonics test results are sent home in due course to parents, once we are informed of the pass mark.

Book sale

On Friday this week, we will be holding a book sale to raise money for our teepee fund. Books will all cost 50p. If you wish your child to buy a book/s please send their money into school in a separate envelope to their tuck shop money and label the envelope 'book sale'. Thanks for your support with this matter - otherwise the children may just spend the extra money at tuck shop!

We hope that you have been enjoying the recent class assemblies in school. We are proud of all of the children for their fantastic hard work in putting these assemblies together for parents.
