- You can't know if someone is LGBT+ just by looking at them








School Diversity week

What is Pride?



What is Pride?

Pride (with a capital P) is a global celebration of the LGBT+ community. It is a time to think about the history of the LGBT+ community and raise awareness of issues that still exist for the LGBT+ community.

June is Pride month and there are events across the globe. Pride events often include parades and marches. You may see lots of things with rainbow flags on them - from clothes, to things around the home and posters.





What does LGBT+ mean?

- L stands for lesbian, a woman who loves another woman
- G stands for gay, a man who loves another man
- B stands for bisexual, a person who loves people of all genders
- T stands for transgender, when someone's gender is different to the gender people thought they were when they were born
- + symbolises the many other people in the LGBT+ community who use different labels to LGBT
