Times tables Key Stage 2

As you know it is very important for the children to learn their times tables and related division facts. Knowing the times tables helps children in many areas of Maths and is a



key skill from an early age. We encourage parents to work with their children to learn their tables

on a regular basis. We are going to try a new system of recording which tables the children know in the form of a book mark. Each child will get a book mark with relevant tables on it.

When they feel they know one of the times tables, the teacher will verbally ask some questions to check this understanding. If they know the table they will get a sticker for it. In order to get a sticker, the children must be able to recall the table quickly and

without counting. It is expected that each child will try for a sticker every week. Once a child has completed the relevant tables bookmark, they will then get a division fact bookmark to work on. The expectations for times tables are as follows:

Year 2 - 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables

Year 3 - 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables

Year 4 - All tables to 12×12

Year 5 - All tables to 12×12

Year 6 - All tables to 12×12

Please encourage your child to use the times table mat that we sent home in Autumn term to really learn their tables inside out. If you require a new times tables mat, please speak to your child's class teacher thanks.

SAT meeting Year 2 parents

On Monday this week Miss Knowles ran an informative after school session for Year 2 parents about the upcoming SATs and assessment of Year 2 children in Summer term. We hope that you found it useful.
