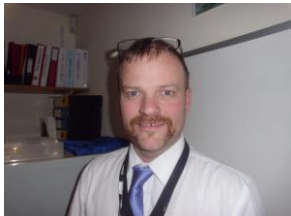
JOINOS - a new communication and school meal payment website

For assistance when entering your code:-

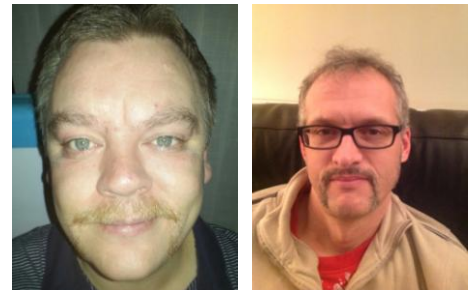
- O - alphabetical capital
