Year 1 children will sit the phonics check and Year 4 will sit the multiplication check in the next two weeks. If you would like to further support your child at home, please speak to your child's class teacher.

Sports Day

We are looking forward to celebrating Sports Day on Wednesday 18th June from 1.15pm weather permitting. Our sports day will take place from 1:15pm until around 3:15pm. As you arrive you will find a place to sit. Chairs will be provided and placed on the field in between the KS1 and KS2 sections of

the event. Staff will then bring the children out in their classes to begin.

There will be two tracks marked out on the KS2 field. Reception, Y1 and Y2 on one track and Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6 on the other track. Chairs will be available between both tracks for visiting adults to watch, and teas and coffees will be served.

Please note that the only entry to school will be through the main entrance on Chiltern Road. The gate at the field end of the school will be locked.

The children should come to school wearing their red school PE shorts, castle colour T-shirt and trainers. Children will also need a sun hat, sun cream and water bottle. Please ensure your child also has a waterproof in case of poor weather conditions. We ask that the children wear a T-shirt in their castle colours. The colours are as follows:

Alnwick – Blue Bamburgh – Pink/purple Chillingham – White Dunstanburgh – Green

Newcastle – Red Warkworth – Yellow

In order to ensure smooth running of the event, we ask that parents do not approach their children with food or drinks. Children will be required to stay on the mats and staff will supervise toilet visits.

At the end of the event, children will return into school to get the rest of their belongings and will be dismissed to parents who have attended sports day, likely slightly earlier but from the normal collection points. If you are not attending, the children will be dismissed at the end of the day at the usual time. Let's hope the weather stays fine for it!
