For those parents who remember, we always used to have an ICT suite, but this room was used to create the Nursery. To have an ICT suite again will further enhance our ICT curriculum and opportunities for the children. We will be fitting the ICT suite with 32 PCs and in addition, we are buying 40 new ipads. Here is the work in progress and Mr Russell our ICT subject leader measuring the space for the benching and PCs. It's very exciting!

Mr Russell is currently completing Apple teacher training, and this will have a huge impact on our ICT curriculum and ICT in general.
